

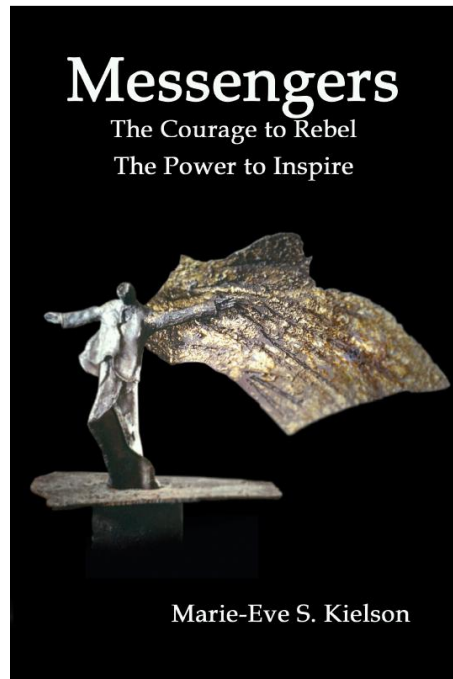
# *Messengers: The Courage to Rebel – The Power to Inspire*
